Robinson Crew wants dedicated student athletes who are willing to work hard and be part of the team's winning tradition! Robinson Crew is a co-ed varsity spring sport open to all Robinson High School students. No rowing experience is required.

Led by Head Coach Jon Barrett, Robinson Crew continued its winning tradition in 2010 by collecting medals in 39 events, including 15 first-place finishes. In post-season competition, the Men's varsity finished 19th in the nation, while the Women's varsity finished first in Virginia and 7th in the nation. Two Robinson Crew rowers were named All Met Athletes by the Washington Post.

Rowers can earn varsity letters and be recruited by some of the most prestigious college programs in the country. Daily after-school practices take place at nearby Sandy Run Regional Park, which is located about a 20-minute drive from Robinson.
